Nominations in order for the Election of the Chair of the City Council to serve until the first Wednesday in December 2025, pursuant to the City Charter, Re: Section 212.

Darci Wheeler, City Clerk called for nominations.

Councilor Dunn nominated Councilor Johnson. Seconded by Councilor McCorkle.

Seeing no other nominations, nominations were closed and roll call was called.

The Council voted 9 yeas and 0 nays to appoint Councilor Johnson as the Council Chair.

Nominations in order for the Election of the Vice-Chair of the City Council to serve until the first Wednesday in December 2025, pursuant to the City Charter, Re: Section 212.

Chair Johnson asked for nominations for Vice Chair.

Councilor Mansfield-Pryor nominated Councilor Ambrosino. Seconded by Councilor Marks.

Seeing no other nominations, Chair Johnson closed nominations and called for a roll call vote.

The Council voted 8 yeas and 0 nays to appoint Councilor Ambrosino as the Council Vice-Chair.

The Organizational Meeting concluded at 6:09 PM with motion by Councilor Ambrosino and seconded by Councilor Dunn. A roll call vote was taken and passed with 8 yeas and 0 nays. The Council went directly into the Regular Meeting.
