

Economic Development Committee October 26, 2022 Bath City Hall Auditorium MEETING MINUTES

Approval of Minutes: Motion seconded and passed. Timm abstained.

Presentation by Midcoast Youth Center: Jamie Dorr provided an overview of Midcoast Youth Center, the Working Communities Challenge, and a Workforce Development initiative.

Microcapital Loan: The Bath Development Corporation has launched a program to offer loan to small businesses for capital expenses. Loans are up to \$7,500 with a two year repayment. Start ups may apply but preference is given to businesses open for 6 months.

Business Survey: DeChant would like to survey businesses. MSB typically does business surveys every 2-3 years. MSB Economic Vitality Committee is looking into what the previous surveys have looked like. This is likely a 2023 activity. A survey by the Economic Development Committee should reach businesses beyond the downtown. Also, it was suggested that an attempt to reach remote workers and home businesses be made.

Bath Fiber Optic Alliance: The Bath Fiber Optic Alliance is a newly formed group interested in advocating for the expansion of fiber infrastructure to those households not included in the current build out of GoNetSpeed fiber, which is about 500 households in North and South Bath. The Alliance is going to apply for a planning grant to get understanding of what the options are.

Comp Plan: The City is going to hire a consultant for the final phase of wrapping up the Comp Plan process. It is expected that a few public meetings will occur in the next few months and that the plan is wrapped up by summer.

Motorcoach Network: Ruger has contacted with Chiara Moriconi from the Maine Office of Tourism. Chiara will be able to present in November.

MCOG strategic planning: Meyers will facilitate setting up a meeting in December with MCOG to share about their strategic plan with the Committee.
