The Joint Standing Conmittee on new streets to whom was referred the petition for a new street to be called "Guddard Screet have perfurmed their duties in confirmity to the law, and have examined deeds and boundary lines of property situated on said street and would recommend that a street Forty Fee (40) wide be laid out from Marshall Street to Getchell Street in accordance with the deeds and lines already bounding said street and when amicably agreed upon that the street shall be accepted as a new street to be known as Goddard Street and recorded. No damages claimed or remonstrance made at the legally advertised hearing.
