



Bath Sidewalk Project—Route 1

Dear Neighbor: The City of Bath has done preliminary engineering to create new sidewalks along both sides of Route 1 between High Street and Congress Avenue.

You are invited to a public information meeting to view the proposed sidewalk design plans. City staff and engineers from Gorrill Palmer will be on hand to present the preliminary plans and answer questions about the project.

The engineering design work is 80% funded by the Maine Department of Transportation. Funding and a time frame for construction has not yet been established. However it is not expected before 2024.

This work may impact properties abutting the Route 1 corridor. If you own one of those parcels, or if you or someone you know has an interest in this proposed project, please plan to attend this meeting so that we may hear your concerns and gather your input.
